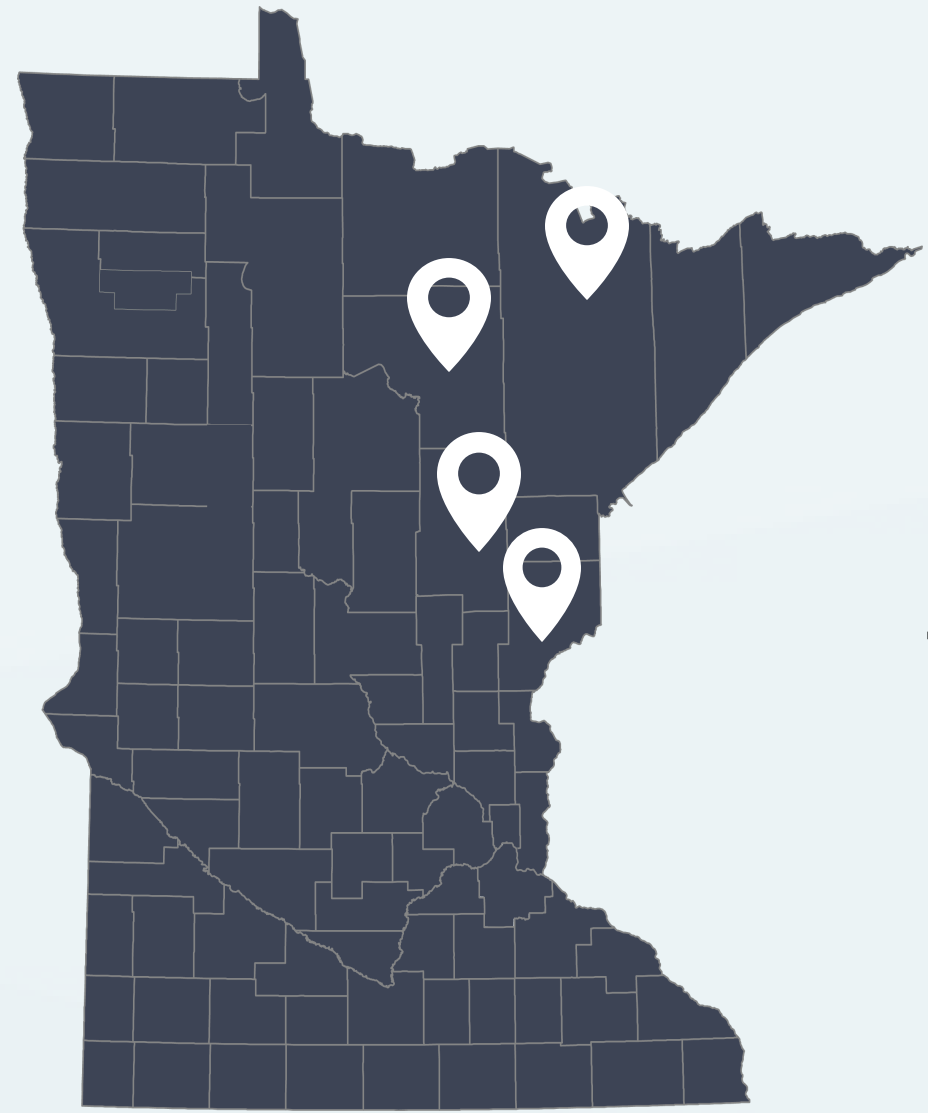
## About the Position

- Ability to contribute to Extension's commitment to equity, diversity and inclusion through teaching and outreach.
- Experience and/or education in a health related area for 6 years or a Bachelor's degree in a health related field with 2 years of related experience.
- An understanding of the diversity of shared values, practices and beliefs across Indian Country.
- Worked or lived in an American Indian community.
- Experience planning, teaching and organizing events.
- Proficient written and verbal communication skills and basic computer skills (Microsoft Word, PowerPoint, email, etc.)
- Valid driver's license and reliable vehicle with required liability insurance, to be utilized for frequent travel within Minnesota and infrequent travel outside Minnesota.
- A personal cell phone that can be used, as needed, for work purposes.
- The ability to maintain a flexible work schedule, including some evenings and weekends.

The work area for this position will include tribal nations and counties in northeast Minnesota. Office location is flexible and based on availability. Possible locations include Aitkin, Itasca, Pine, or northern St. Louis counties.
