Amended Conservation Code for the Minnesota Portion of the 1837 Ceded Territory

PURPOSE: Fond du Lac Ordinance #02/97 § 3.30 provides that a member's **immediate** family, including grandparents, parents, children, spouses, and siblings, may assist a member in exercising treaty activities within the **1837 Minnesota ceded territory only**.

REQUIREMENTS: A member may be assisted by a non-member **ONLY** if the non-member is listed on a Permit to Assist, **AND** the member is physically present during the activity which constitutes assistance.

RESTRICTIONS: Non-member assistance is limited to:

- (1) operation of a boat during spearing;
- (2) lifting a net;
- (3) lifting of attended lines during ice fishing;
- (4) in hunting, all activities except the actual use of a firearm, bow and arrow, or crossbow to kill an animal;
- (5) in trapping and snaring, all activities except the setting or placement of traps and snares;
- (6) in harvesting wild rice, all activities, and in harvesting other plants, all activities except the uprooting, cutting, or removal of plant matter from its natural location; and
- (7) in harvesting frogs, turtles, mussels, crayfish, and species the harvest of which are not prohibited or otherwise regulated by Fond du Lac Ordinance #02/97, all activities except the actual use of a device to kill an animal or the specific act which reduces an animal to possession.
