

FOND DU LAC GENERAL RESERVATION ELECTION BOARD

For the health and safety of our community and voters

In conjunction with current COVID-19 practices the Fond du Lac Election Board is setting the following procedures for the June 9, 2020 Primary Election.

POLLING STATIONS: BROOKSTON & CLOQUET COMMUNITY CENTERS

OPENS: 8:00 A.M.

CLOSES: 8:00 P.M.

- No more than five voters will be allowed in the building during voting hours. The election board and election services staff equals 5 people. This meets the 10-person requirement for small gatherings.
- Floor space will be marked off to meet 6' social distancing requirement.
- Voters are encouraged to wear face mask; hand sanitizer station will be setup. This will be used for both entering and leaving polling station.
- Voting stations will be cleaned before each voter uses station: stations will be wiped down.
- The count will be broadcast through the Fond du Lac Facebook page to facilitate voter observation of the count. The General and District Board Members along with a FDL police officer will be physically present for the count. Each candidate or a representative of the candidate can be physically present for the count.
- Voters will be screened for COVID-19 symptoms before entering the polling stations. Voters showing COVID-19 symptoms will need to either vote in their vehicle or outside if individuals do not have access to a vehicle.

The Fond du Lac Election Board continues to encourage Absentee Ballot voting process before June 9th, 2020.

These procedures are subject to change as state health regulations related to COVID-19 evolve.
