

The Indian Health Service is offering full scholarships.

*The Indian Health Service Health Professions Scholarship provides financial aid covering tuition, required fees, and other educational and living expenses for qualified American Indian and Alaska Native students enrolled in a health profession degree program.*

*Recipients of the scholarship are required to fulfill a service commitment at an Indian health facility one year of service for each year of support, for a maximum of 4 years full-time and 8 years part-time.*

The eligible degree programs are diverse and include:

- Medicine — Allopathic and Osteopathic doctorate degrees
- Nursing — Bachelor of Science (BSN)
- Nursing — Nurse Practitioner/Advanced Practice Nurse (NP, DNP)
- Nursing — Certified Nurse Midwife (CNM)
- Certified Registered Nurse Anesthetist (CRNA)
- Physician Assistant
- Dentistry — DDS or DMD
- Social Work — Master's degree
- Clinical Psychology — PhD or PsyD
- Counseling Psychology — PhD
- Optometry — OD
- Pharmacy — PharmD
- Podiatry — DPM
- Physical Therapy — DPT
- Chiropractic — DC

The application due date is February 28, 2021, 7:00 p.m. Eastern which gives people time to prepare and submit an application.
