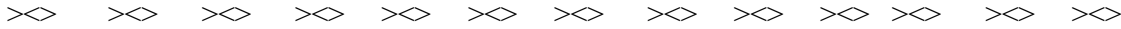


# 2022 FALL WHITEFISH/TULLIBEE NETTING IN 1854 CEDED TERRITORY



**The weather may be finally getting cold enough for Whitefish/Tullibee season!**

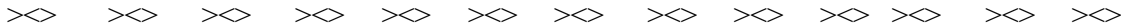
Netting Season for will run from **Mid-October through Friday, December 23, 2022**

Fond du Lac Band members can pick up a permit and a self-creel log book from the FDL Resource Management Division. This permit is valid for 14 days. FDL Band members may declare up to three lakes for netting. Lakes (county) available for declaration include the following:

Bear Island, St. Louis	Basswood, Lake	Brule, Cook
Crane, St. Louis	Fall, Lake	Caribou, Cook
Elbow, St. Louis	Isabella, Lake	Devil Track, Cook
